Preface

The situation in East Asia is still uncertain and unstable even 10 years after the end of the Cold War. We witnessed in 1999 the lingering fear of another North Korea's missile launch, strained U.S.-China relations and the chaos in East Timor. Against this background, regional stability and security requires active, constructive and objective discussions on the key issues of regional security, and mutual understanding based thereon. This is the very aim East Asian Strategic Review 2000 tries to achieve.

Published by the National Institute for Defense Studies (NIDS), the main policy research arm of the Defense Agency of Japan and a defense-college level senior educational institution, this publication represents the efforts of the NIDS research staff to present their own perspectives on the strategic environment of East Asia. In the process of making this report, we are greatly helped by invaluable comments and suggestions that our international colleagues shared with us on various occasions — including seminars hosted by our institution.
